


Image 2. Bonkers.ie results page for Gas Only




Image 3. Bonkers.ie results page for Electricity Only




Image 4. Bonkers.ie results page for Dual Fuel




Image 5. Bonkers.ie How is bonkers.ie free?




Image 6. Bonkers.ie How does Bonkers.ie make money?




Image 7. Bonkers.ie results page




Image 8. Bonkers.ie results page, option to compare multi-year




Image 9. Summary tariff details page




Image 10a. Dual Fuel - Electricity tariff details




Image 10b. Dual Fuel - Gas tariff details




Image 10c. Dual Fuel - Summary calculation details




Image 11. Non-cash offers




Image 13a. Results page - Payment available




Image 14. Offers not included in the default price comparison.




Image 15. Details including recurring discounts and fixed charges




Image 16a. See calculations link on the Result page.




Image 18. Contract length and exit fee information.




Image 19. Split of 50% day and 50% night




Image 21. Electricity and Gas consumption filter options and CRU average details.




Image 24a. Electricity calculation details of savings to the new plan.




Image 24b. Gas calculation details of savings to the new plan.




Image 25a. Unit Rates, Standing Charge inclusive and exclusive VAT and PSO Levy.




Image 25b. Prices, Standing Charge inclusive and exclusive VAT and Carbon tax.




Image 26. Requirements of each tariff option.




Image 27. Filters options.




Image 30. The results page only shows plans the customer can switch to today.




Image 31. Results page showing all plans available




Image 32. 100% Green electricity options.




Image 33. 'Only show' 100% green electricity filter




Image 33a. 100% green electricity results page "see detail" information link.




Image 33b. 100% green electricity details on a specific tariff.




Image 34. Fuel mix details on a specific tariff with CRU link.

13. What are the different payment methods available to me?

When switching the best deals are usually reserved for those who choose to pay by direct debit. This is because the supplier saves on administration costs and in turn is able to pass on some of those savings to you.

Many new tariffs are only available to customers prepared to pay by direct debit, however other payment methods are also available.

Direct debit

As mentioned, paying by direct debit is more convenient and usually cheaper than paying by cash or cheque. It's also the most common payment type nowadays. When your supplier sends you a bill either in the post or electronically, a date will be included when you can expect payment to be deducted from your bank account. You are usually given notice of two weeks before payment is expected. Many of the cheapest electricity and gas tariffs are available to customers paying by direct debit only. To pay by direct debit, you must provide your supplier with your bank sort code and account number, or your IBAN.

Cash or cheque

Some deals will allow you to pay by cash or cheque at a payment centre like a post office or in your bank. These tariffs are usually more expensive than paying by direct debit though.

Pre-payment

You can also choose to pay for your energy in advance by getting a pre-payment meter installed and topping up your account with credit. This credit can usually be bought in shops or purchased online.

With pre-payment plans you will have one less bill in the post to worry about. However these plans are usually a good bit more expensive than normal bill pay/direct debit deals.




Image 36. Bonkers.ie comparison page.




Image 37. Bonkers.ie tariff details page, link to supplier's T&C.




Image 38. Bonkers.ie search results page.




Image 39b. Bonkers.ie footer, CRU logo with a link to Accredited by the CRU page.




Image 40a. Bonkers.ie privacy policy page.

Image 40c. Cookie Consent pop up




Image 40d. Privacy preferences

Test scenarios validation procedure

The validation procedure was defined as the following steps to be executed for each scenario:

- 1. User access to Bonkers.ie comparison website and introduces the current tariff input parameters:
 - Current Supplier
 - Supply Region: Urban or Rural
 - What type of meter do you have? Standard Meter or Smart Meter
 - Night saver meter: Yes or No
 - How bills are paid: Direct Debit, Cash or cheque or Pay As you go / Prepayment
 - The National average is selected (4,200 kWh for electricity or 11,000 kWh for gas)

In addition, some parameters are introduced with default values:

- Include cash-back amounts in calculations? Yes or No. 'No' is selected by default.
- Only show tariffs available for sign up? Yes or No. 'No' is selected by default
- 2. The user clicks on "Compare prices".
 - Results page is opened. The resulting plans are sorted by price (best offer first).
 - Top banner presents the calculated costs for the current plan.

- 3. The user clicks on the 'See calculations' link to obtain the Estimated Annual Bill of the current plan. Then, the user clicks on 'x' to close the popup and to return to the previous Results page.
- 4. User selects the first offer and clicks 'see calculations' to obtain the new plan breakdown of the price and savings.
 - Bonkers.ie shows the breakdown of the prices for the new plan
 - Total savings for the current energy plan and the new energy plan.
- 5. User browses to the current supplier's website to obtain details of the current tariff.
 - Selects the current energy plan, and take note of the standing charge rates, consumption rate (day and night when it proceeds) and taxes.
- 6. User calculates the cost for the national average consumption with the given data and identifies whether the calculated price matches the one presented by Bonkers.ie website.
- 7. User browses the new recommended supplier's website to obtain details of the new tariff.
 - Selects the new energy plan, and take note of the standing charge rates, consumption rate (day and night when it proceeds) and taxes.
- 8. User calculates the cost for the national average consumption with the given data and identifies whether the calculated price matches the one presented by Bonkers ie website.

If the calculated tariffs on step 6 and step 8 are correct, the test scenario is considered successful and noted as PASS.






