Re: Approval of 110kV Distribution Use of System Charges

Dear Gay

I am writing to you pursuant to the Commission's powers under Section 36(3) of the Electricity Regulation Act, 1999.

ESB Networks has, at the request of the Commission, submitted for approval a statement of 110kV Distribution Use of System charges. The requirement to introduce an 110kV charge follows the connection of a customer to the 110kV distribution system for the first time. The following charges were proposed by ESB Networks:

DESCRIPTION OF CHARGE	AMOUNT	UNIT
STANDING	€ 10,377	Per month
MIC (kVA)	€ 0.32	Per month per kVA
DAY KWH	0.043c	Per kWh
NIGHT KWH	0.003c	Per kWh

The Commission has examined this statement and hereby approves it in accordance with Section 36(3) of the 1999 Act. The Commission directs that these charges come into effect from the date of connection of the first 110kV distribution connected customer.
